Average Residential Customer & Proposed Rate Structure

Average Monthly Usage for Residential Customers	6,400 gallons
Cost for 6,400 gallons under Proposed Rate Structure	\$58.16 (currently \$57.52)
Average Residential Customer Cost Increase Per Month	\$0.64 (1% increase)

The proposed rate change is an increase to the Water Resource Utilization Fee of ten cents per thousand gallons, from \$0.40 to \$0.50. The Water Resources Utilization Fee generates revenue to develop, design, and construct projects that will put to use the District's CAP water and effluent. The District recently approved a connection with Tucson Water as part of an agreement to deliver CAP water to Lazy B to provide greater redundancy and reliability for the area. By using this Fee, the District avoids adding additional debt and reduces the financial impact of these initiatives.

Commercial and multi-family customers' rates will be equated to this proposed rate schedule according to their larger meter sizes.
