On Monday, May 13, 2024, Borderland Construction, under contract with Metro Water, Town of Oro Valley, and Town of Marana (the Partners) will be starting work on the Northwest Recharge, Recovery and Delivery System (also known as NWRRDS) Partnered Project. This project will consist of installing a new waterline along Avra Valley Road from approximately the Marana Regional Airport (western limit) to a parcel that is on Twin Peaks Road, northeast of the Tucson Premium Outlets (eastern limit).

Most of the waterline work will parallel Avra Valley Road but will be located out of the travel lanes. Temporary construction access to the work zone will be from the roadway shoulders and will be delineated with the use of temporary traffic control devices/barricades. There will be heavy equipment as well as large trucks working along this alignment, and we ask that the public please proceed with caution around barricaded areas.

There will be an intermittent construction crossing of Avra Valley (just east of Safford Street) and intermittent side street crossings through the Happy Acres neighborhood. As we get closer to the roadway crossing dates, additional public notification of temporary traffic control changes will be provided via onsite message boards.

Our work will start west of Airline Road and continue east towards the Santa Cruz River Bridge, per the map below. We will eventually have several simultaneous areas under construction and aim to minimize any major impediments and disruptions to the public. We appreciate your understanding and patience as we complete this project.
